Physicians' Certificate.

W. F. Beer and H. N. Mayo
being duly sworn, both certify, each for himself, that he is a practicing physician in medicine, that at the request and in
the presence of Hon. Wm. C. Hall, Judge of the Third Judicial District,
he has heard the testimony and personally examined the said Annie Jonas in reference
to the charge of insanity, and both find that she is insane and so far disordered
in her mind as to endanger health, person or property, and that said insanity is not a case of idiocy, imbecility or simple
feebleness of mind; the further facts appertaining to said case, as nearly as can be ascertained, are set forth in the answers
to the following questions:

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1. Name? Annie Jonas
2. Age? 38
3. Nativity? American
4. Married or single? Married
5. If children, how many, their names, ages and residences? Five - Margarita, 17; Rosie, 15; John, 13; William, 11; Joseph, 9; Sandy, Utah.
6. If female and married, maiden name and name of husband? Nelson; Joseph Jonas
7. What State last from and how long in Utah? Born & raised in Utah; Lived in Washington State 16 years prior to July 4th 1901.

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8. What occupation? ... **Housewife**
9. What evidence have you of the presence of insanity? ... **Personal examination & testimony of witnesses**

10. Is there a homicidal, suicidal or incendiary disposition? ... **Yes; No; No**

11. Is the case a recent one, having occurred within twelve months last past? ... **No** ... **Twelve years standing**

12. When did this attack first appear? ... **Ten years ago**

13. Is this the first attack; if not, when did others occur, and what their duration? ... **No** ... **She showed mental trouble two years before**

14. Is the disease increasing, decreasing or stationary? ... **Increasing**

15. Are there rational intervals; if so, do they occur periodically? ... **Yes; No**

16. Is there any permanent hallucination; if so, what is it? ... **Yes; Fairies**

17. In what way is the accused dangerous to be at large? ... **Will injure others**

18. Is there a disposition to injure others; if so, is it directed especially to relatives? Is it from sudden passion or premeditated? ... **Yes; Yes; Sudden passion**

19. If suicidal, is the propensity now active, and in what way? ... **No**

20. Is there a disposition to filthy habits; destruction of clothing, furniture, etc.? ... **No; Yes**

21. Have any relatives, including grandparents and cousins been insane? ... **No**

22. Any peculiarity of habits, temper, disposition, etc., or pursuits or religious impressions? ... **Strays away from home - Sees Fairies & - Uses abusive language**

23. Been intemperate in the use of ardent spirits, wine, opium or tobacco in any form? ... **No**

24. Suffered from epilepsy, suppressed secretions, eruptions, discharges or sores, or injured in the head? ... **No; No; No; No**
